Around 700 hrs of Extensive CRT training for 116 days was given to final year students.

70% of the all eligible candidates have been placed in various companies. 49 placement companies have already visited our campus and recruited our final year students and 30 more companies are still expected before the end of this academic year for further recruitment.

#### **08. Upgradation of infrastructural facilities / Curriculum**

- ❖ Theory of Machines Lab has been installed where students can perform at least 12 experiments
- ❖ Fluid Mechanics & Hydraulics Lab has been equipped with new equipment where students of both Civil & Mechanical can easily perform 15 experiments.
- ❖ Machine tools, Metrology & Thermal Labs were equipped with new equipment.
- ❖ Advanced manufacturing systems Lab with Robotic Arm Make FANUC, USA, Rs.18,00,000/-, Vertical Milling machine Make ACE Microtech Labs Rs.28,70,000/- and CNC turning machines Make ACE Microtech Labs Rs.20,00,000/- has been started to enhance the quality of students projects, consultancy and for cutting edged research.
- ❖ Digital Electronics Lab with Digital IC trainer kits has been introduced parallel to theory classes
- ❖ Environment, Concrete & Transport labs were upgraded to the state of art facilities with able experiments at a cost of 20 lakhs.
- ❖ Electrical machines lab have been upgraded with 4 more equipments costing Rs. 4,00,000/-.
- ❖ 120 PCs were procured for computer centre as well as mechanical department.
- ❖ Additional new bus routes were introduced to facilitate the students coming from remote areas like Kothavalasa, Salur and Bobbili.

#### **Proposed / under Upgradation**

- ❖ All existing building elevations are being uplifted and will be completed by June 2019.
- ❖ The grand entry for the main campus which is already in progress and will be completed by Jan 2019
- ❖ The first phase of the students seating court is completed and the second phase will be completed by Jan 2019.
- ❖ The basket ball & volleyball courts will be completed by March 2019.
- ❖ New electrical block with an area of approx 46000 Sq.ft. is planned and will be completed by June 2019.
- ❖ Construction of new cafeteria centrally air conditioned of 15000 Sq.ft has started and will be completed soon.
- ❖ Construction of new building of 8 floors with 68000 Sq.ft. has started and is nearing completion.

#### **Case Studies**

Case studies for each subjects has been introduced which refers to the use of a descriptive research approach to obtain an in-depth analysis of a phenomenon. Students were given 3 slots for each subject and for each unit. Topics related to that unit were given and asked to present before faculty. The presentations made were recorded and stored for future reference.

### **Mini Projects**

With the motive to increase the students reporting skills and thinking capabilities, students were asked to submit Mini Projects by using the knowledge that they have acquired throughout lab.

### **Smart Class Rooms**

Every class is equipped with projector and faculty have used presentations and videos to deliver lectures.

### **Ready for Industry**

Main motive behind this is to prepare a student ready for industry as soon as he passes out from college. As a part of it we have signed MOU with Dassault Systems. All our 2<sup>nd</sup> year students are learning design software CATIA, MATLAB.

### **Seminars**

Students were given 15 current research topics on the subjects they have learned and were asked to present before external examiner.

### **Feedback**

Feed back of faculty, students, alumni & parents is being considered to evaluate the utility content of the curriculum.

### **Value Added / Certificate Courses**

Various Value Added and certificate courses have been introduced. Each faculty and student must register the required NPTEL (MOOCs) courses during the part of teaching and learning practice. Value added courses for the subjects EDC, RVSP, AC & EMWTL have been included in the regular curriculum.

### **Faculty**

To ensure that the syllabi is covered without any interruption every semester, an undertaking has been taken from all faculties stating that they will no way leave the college in between the semester, if in any case they have to leave in the middle of semester they will pay 3 month's salary for getting relieved from the organization.

The clause no. 4.12.2 of HR manual has been revised i.e., the term of three months notice period has been changed to one month. The notice is to be given before the completion of running semester for getting relieved from the services of the organization.

To regularize the staff leave position a new ERP system has been introduced as paper less system in addition to regular bio-metric system. Faculty can apply for regular leaves as well as assigned duty leaves through this system.

Our college has been recognized as one of the training centres to provide on job training to Govt polytechnic students. Accordingly, full pledged training is provided in different sections of the college.

Mr. S. Rajesh. Asst Professor of Mechanical dept was awarded young scientist award in the science festival conducted at Lucknow by Ministry of science and Technology.

### **Faculty Development Programme**

MOU has been signed between JNTUK, Kakinada & Raghu Engineering College for conducting FDP's and guest lectures. JNTUK Kakinada has been identified as a Hub institution sanctioned by SHARE AND MENTOR INSTITUTIONS (MARGDARSHAN)-AICTE to organize six Faculty Development Programs (FDP) and 25 guest lectures to the faculty of spoke institutes.

- ❖ The success rate is more than 70% in regular examinations conducted so far. It is observed that there is a good percentage of improvement compared to the previous non-autonomous stream.


