Sports-persons may be permitted full credit for lectures/practicals missed by them as a result of their participation in inter-collegiate, inter-university,
State, National and International tournaments and coaching camps
Organised in preparation of these tournaments. This credit may
be allowed on the basis of production of a certificate for
participated in authorised sporting event(s) from the organisers the event(s). However, the total period of absence in case of State/National level sports events and in International sports events should not exceed 30 days and 45 days, respectively including the journey period, in an academic year. In exceptional cases, further relaxation beyon' these time periods , may be permitted to protect the academic and sports interests of the sports-persons by the Vice-chancellor of the University. In the event of a sport-person being absent for a long period of time for coaching camps, efforts should be made by the or-

ganising authority to arrange for all possible educational facilities including use of library. The Colleges/Universities may also consider organising classes/practicals and providing other facilities to the sports-persons for making up loss of studies due to their long absence from their institution.

- Half railway concession may be provided to the sports-persons for participating in the authorised sports events/coaching Campa.
- TA/DA and halting allowance: may be provided by the University to the sports-persons, in case the organisors have not extended any such facility to the persons.
- G. Sports kit/uniform may be provided by the University to the plays of University team, free of charge.
- Tan percent seats in first year of the Under-graduate level Degree courses-pass courses and Hon.courses, may be reserved for sports-persons who have represented the State or Nation inthe National or International level sport events. However, for Admission, such sport-persons should have obtained the minimum cut off percentage of marks in their previous examinations. For admission in B.Ed., course, 3% seats may be reserved.
- 8. The spor's persons who are unable to take the examination because of his/her participation in coaching camp/tournament may be permitted to move to the next class and keep terms in higher classes. They may, therefore, be permitted to appear in the subsequent examination and carry credit for the papers Cloured from one communitation to enother till the entire course in completed and he/she becomes eligible for the award of Degree.

## AUTONOMOUS COLLEGES OF JNTUK COMMON ACADEMIC REGULATIONS (R20) FOR B. TECH PROGRAMME

(Applicable for from the Academic Year 2020-21)

#### 1. Award of B. Tech. Degree

(a) A student will be declared eligible for the award of B. Tech. Degree if he fulfils the following

academic regulations:

(i) A student shall be declared eligible for the award of B. Tech Degree, if he pursues a course of study in not less than four and not more than eight academic years. After eight academic years from the year of their admission, he/she shall forfeit their seat in B. Tech course and their admission stands cancelled.

(ii) The candidate shall register for 160 credits and secure all the 160 credits.

(b) The medium of instruction for the entire under graduate programme in Engineering & Technology will be in English only.

2. Programme Pattern:

a) Total duration of the of B. Tech (Regular) Programme is four academic years

b) Each Academic year of study is divided into Two Semesters.

c) Minimum number of instruction days in each semester is 90.

d) Grade points, based on percentage of marks awarded for each course will form the basis for calculation of SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average) and CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average).

e) The total credits for the Programme is 160.

f) Three week induction program is mandatory for all first year UG students and shall be conducted as per AICTE/UGC/APSCHE guidelines.

g) Student is introduced to "Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)".

h) A pool of interdisciplinary and job-oriented mandatory skill courses which are relevant to the industry are integrated into the curriculum of concerned branch of engineering (total five skill courses: two basic level skill courses, one on soft skills and other two on advanced level skill courses)

A student has to register for all courses in a semester.

All the registered credits will be considered for the calculation of final CGPA.

k) Each semester has - 'Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE)' and 'Semester End Examination (SEE)'. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Credit Based Semester System (CBSS) as indicated by UGC and course structure as suggested by AICTE are followed.

1) A 10 months industry/field mandatory internship, both industry and social, during the summer vacation and also in the final semester to acquire the skills required for job and make engineering graduates to connect with the needs of the industry and society at large.

m) All the students shall be mandatorily registered for NCC, NSS activities and Community Service

Project as per the Government and University norms.

n) Each college shall assign a faculty advisor/mentor after admission to each student or group of students from same department to provide guidance in courses registration/career growth/placements/opportunities for higher studies/GATE/other competitive exams etc.

3. Registration for Courses:

a) In each semester a student shall mandatorily register courses which he/she wishes to pursue within a week from the starting of the class work with the advice of Head of the Department and mentor of the student of the concerned department of the college.

b) If any student wishes to withdraw the registration of the course, he/she shall submit a letter to the Principal of the college through the Head of the Department and mentor within fifteen days.

c) The concerned college shall thoroughly verify and upload the data/courses registered by each student in the university examination center within 20 days. The Principal of the concerned college shall ensure that there are no wrong registration courses by the student. The university registration portal will be closed after 20 days.

4. (a) Award of B. Tech. Degree: A student will be declared eligible for the award of B. Tech. Degree if he fulfills the following academic regulations:

- i. A student shall be declared eligible for award of the B. Tech Degree, if he pursues a course of study in not less than four and not more than eight academic years. After eight academic years from the year of their admission, he/she shall forfeit their seat in B. Tech course and their admission stands cancelled.
- ii. The student shall register for 160 credits and must secure all the 160 credits.
- iii. All students shall mandatorily register for the courses like Environmental Sciences, Universal Human Values, Ethics, Indian Constitution, Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge etc., shall be included in the curriculum as non-credit mandatory courses. Environmental Sciences is to be offered compulsorily as mandatory course for all branches. A student has to secure at least 40% of the marks allotted in the internal evaluation for passing the course and shall maintain 75% of attendance in the subject.
- iv. All students shall mandatorily register for NCC/NSS activities and will be required to participate in an activity specified by NSS officer during second and third semesters. Grade shall be awarded as Satisfactory or Unsatisfactory in the mark sheet on the basis of participation, attendance, performance and behavior. If a student gets an unsatisfactory Grade, he/she shall repeat the above activity in the subsequent years, in order to complete the degree requirements.
- v. Credits are defined as per AICTE norms.
- (b) Award of B. Tech. (Honor)/B. Tech. (Minor): B. Tech. with Honors or a B. Tech. with a Minor will be awarded if the student earns 20 additional credits are acquired as per the regulations/guidelines. The regulations/guidelines are separately provided. Registering for an Honors/Minor is optional.

#### 5. Attendance Requirements

- a) A student is eligible to write the examinations if he acquires a minimum of 40% in each subject and 75% of attendance in aggregate of all the subjects.
- b) Condonation of shortage of attendance in aggregate up to 10% (65% and above, and below 75%) may be granted by the College Academic Committee. However, this condonation concession is applicable only to any two semesters during the entire programme.
- c) Shortage of Attendance below 65% in aggregate shall not be condoned.
- d) A student who is short of attendance in a semester may seek re-admission into that semester when offered within 4 weeks from the date of commencement of class work.
- e) Students whose shortage of attendance is not condoned in any semester are not eligible to write their end semester examination of that class.
- f) A stipulated fee of Rs. 500/- in the concerned semester shall be payable towards condonation of shortage of attendance. Students availing condonation on medical ground shall produce a medical certificate issued by the competitive authority.
- g) A student will be promoted to the next semester if he satisfies the (i) attendance requirement of the present semester and (ii) minimum required credits.
- h) If any candidate fulfills the attendance requirement in the present semester, he shall not be eligible for readmission into the same class.
- i) For induction programme attendance shall be maintained as per AICTE norms.
- j) For non-credit mandatory courses the students shall maintain the attendance similar to credit courses

#### 6. Evaluation-Distribution and Weightage of marks

- (i) Paper setting and evaluation of the answer scripts shall be done as per the procedures laid down by the Examination section from time to time.
- (ii) To maintain the quality, external examiners and question paper setters shall be selected from reputed institutes like IISc, IITs, IIITs, IISERs, NITs and Universities.
- (iii) For non-credit mandatory courses, like Environmental Sciences, Universal Human Values, Ethics, Indian Constitution, Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge, the student has to secure 40% of the

marks allotted in the internal evaluation for passing the course. No marks or letter grade shall be allotted for all mandatory non-credit courses.

(iv) A student is deemed to have satisfied the minimum academic requirements if he has earned the credits allotted to each theory/practical design/drawing subject/ project etc by securing not less than 35% of marks in the end semester exam and minimum 40% of marks in the sum total of the internal marks and

end semester examination marks together. (v) Distribution and Weightage of marks:

(vi) Continuous Internal Theory Evaluation:

a) For theory subjects, during a semester, there shall be two mid-term examinations. Each mid-term examination consists of (i) one online objective examination (20 multiple choice questions) for 10 marks for a duration of 20 minutes (ii) one descriptive examination (3 full questions for 5 marks each) for 15 marks for a duration of 90 minutes and (iii) one assignment for 5 marks. All the internal exams shall be conducted as per Institutional norms. Mid-I examination shall be conducted from first two units of the syllabi and Mid-II from the remaining three units of the syllabi. The Mid-I question paper consists of two questions from first unit and one question from second unit, whereas the Mid-II examination question paper consists of one question each from the remaining

The total marks secured by the student in each mid-term examination are evaluated for 25 marks along with 5 marks of assignment shall be submitted to the controller of examination within one

week from the completion of internal examinations.

b) The mid marks submitted to the examination section shall be displayed in the concerned college notice boards for the benefit of the students.

c) If any discrepancy found in the submitted Mid-1 marks, it shall be brought to the notice of

examination section within one week from the submission.

d) Second mid marks (Mid-2) consisting of marks of online objective examination, descriptive examination and assignment shall also be submitted to examination section within one week after completion of second mid examination and it shall be displayed in the notice boards. If any discrepancy found in the submitted mid-2 marks, it shall be brought to the notice of examination section within one week from the submission.

e) Internal marks can be calculated with 70% weightage for better of the two mids and 30% Weightage

for other mid exam.

Example:

Mid-1 marks = Marks secured in (online examination-1+descriptive examination-1 +one assignment-1)

Mid-2 marks = Marks secured in (online examination-2+descriptive examination-2 +one assignment-2)

Final internal Marks = (Best of (Mid-1/Mid-2) marks x 0.7 + Least of (Mid-1/Mid-2) marks x 0.3)

- f) With the above criteria, examination section will send mid marks of all subjects in consolidated form to all the concerned departments and same shall be displayed in the concerned department notice boards. If any discrepancy found, it shall be brought to the notice of examination section through proper channel within one week with all proofs. Discrepancies brought after the given deadline will not be entertained under any circumstances.

a) The semester end examinations will be conducted by examination section for 70 marks consists of five questions carrying 14 marks each. Each of these questions is from one unit and may contain sub-questions. For each question there will be an "either" "or" choice, which means that there will be two questions from each unit and the student should answer either of the two questions.

b) For practical subjects there shall be continuous evaluation during the semester for 15 internal marks and 35 end examination marks. The internal 15 marks shall be awarded as follows: day to day work
 5 marks, Record-5 marks and the remaining 5 marks to be awarded by conducting an internal laboratory test. The end examination shall be conducted by the teacher concerned and external

examiner appointed.

c) For the subject having design and / or drawing, (such as Engineering Graphics, Engineering Drawing, Machine Drawing) and estimation, the distribution shall be 30 marks for internal evaluation (15 marks for continuous Assessment (day-to-day work) and 15 marks for internal tests) and 70 marks for end examination. There shall be two internal tests in a Semester for 15 marks each and final marks can be calculated with 70% weightage for better of the two tests and 30% weightage

for other test and these are to be added to the marks obtained in day to day work.

d) Evaluation of the summer internships: It shall be completed in collaboration with local industries, Goyt, Organizations, construction agencies, Industries, Hydel and thermal power projects and also in software MNCs in the area of concerned specialization of the UG programme. Students shall pursue this course during summer vacation just before its offering as per course structure. The minimum duration of this course is at least 6 weeks. The student shall register for the course as per course structure after commencement of academic year. A supervisor/mentor/advisor has to be allotted to guide the students for taking up the summer internship. The supervisor shall monitor the attendance of the students while taking up the internship. Attendance requirements are as per the norms of the Institution. After successful completion, students shall submit a summer internship technical report to the concerned department and appear for an oral presentation before the departmental committee consists of an external examiner; Head of the Department; supervisor of the internship and a senior faculty member of the department. A certificate from industry/skill development center shall be included in the report. The report and the oral presentation shall carry 40% and 60% weightages respectively. It shall be evaluated for 50 external marks at the end of the semester. There shall be no internal marks for Summer Internship. A student shall secure minimum 40% of marks for successful completion. In case, if a student fails, he/she shall reappear as and when semester supplementary examinations are conducted by the Examination section.

e) The job oriented skill courses may be registered at the college or at any accredited external agency. A student shall submit a record/report on the skills learned. If the student completes job oriented skill course at external agency, a certificate from the agency shall be included in the report. The course will be evaluated at the end of the semester for 50 marks (record: 15 marks and viva-voce: 35 marks) along with laboratory end examinations in the presence of external and internal examiner (course instructor or mentor). There are no internal marks for the job oriented skill courses.

- f) Mandatory Course (M.C): Environmental Sciences, Universal Human Values, Ethics, Indian Constitution, Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge etc non-credit (zero credits) mandatory courses. Environmental Sciences shall be offered compulsorily as mandatory course for all branches. A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory in these subjects. There shall be two class tests conducted at the department level. The weightage of each class test is 30 marks. Attending both the class tests is mandatory. There is no online internal exam for mandatory courses. No marks or letter grade shall be printed in the transcripts for all mandatory non-credit courses, but only Completed (Y)/Not-completed (N) will be specified for the students who secured more than 40% of the marks.
- g) Procedure for Conduct and Evaluation of MOOC: There shall be a Discipline Centric Elective Course through Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) as Program Elective course. The student shall register for the course (Minimum of 12 weeks) offered by SWAYAM/NPTEL through online with the approval of Head of the Department. The Head of the Department shall appoint

one mentor for each of the MOOC subjects offered. The student needs to register the course in the SWAYAM/NPTEL portal. During the course, the mentor monitors the student's assignment submissions given by SWAYAM/NPTEL. The student needs to submit all the assignments given and needs to take final exam at the proctor center. The student needs to earn a certificate by passing the exam. The student will be awarded the credits given in curriculum only by submission of the certificate. In case if student does not pass subjects registered through SWAYAM/NPTEL, the same or alternative equivalent subject may be registered again through SWAYAM/NPTEL in the next semester with the recommendation of HOD and shall be pass.

h) Major Project (Project - Project work, seminar and internship in industry): In the final semester, the student should mandatorily register and undergo internship and in parallel he/she should work on a project with well-defined objectives. At the end of the semester the candidate shall submit an internship completion certificate and a project report. A student shall also be permitted to submit project report on the work carried out during the internship. The project report shall be evaluated with an external examiner. Evaluation: The total marks for project work 200 marks and distribution shall be 60 marks for internal and 140 marks for external evaluation. The supervisor assesses the student for 30 marks (Report: 15 marks, Seminar: 15 marks). At the end of the semester, all projects shall be showcased at the department for the benefit of all students and staff and the same is to be evaluated by the departmental Project Review Committee consisting of supervisor, a senior faculty and HOD for 30 marks. The external evaluation of Project Work is a Viva-Voce Examination conducted in the presence of internal examiner and external examiner and is evaluated for 140 marks.

7. Results Declaration:

(i) Before results declaration, results review meeting shall be conducted and results shall be placed before the results review committee for approval.

8. Academic Audit: Academic audit in each semester will be conducted as per norms.

9. Recounting or Re-evaluation of Marks in the End Semester Examination: A student can request for recounting of revaluation of his/her answer book on payment of a prescribed fee as per Institutional

10. Supplementary Examinations: A student who has failed to secure the required credits can appear for a supplementary examination, as per the schedule announced by the Controller of Examinations.

11. Malpractices in Examinations: Disciplinary action shall be taken in case of malpractices during Mid/End examinations as per the rules framed by the Examination section.

12. Promotion Rules

The following academic requirements have to be satisfied in addition to the attendance requirements mentioned in item no.5 for promotion to higher classes

a) A student shall be promoted from first year to second year if he fulfills the minimum attendance

requirement as per Institutional norms.

- b) A student will be promoted from II year to III year if he fulfills the academic requirement of 40% of credits up to either II year I-Semester or II year II-Semester from all the examinations, whether ornot the candidate takes the examinations and secures prescribed minimum attendance in II year II
- c) A student shall be promoted from III year to IV year if he fulfills the academic requirements of 40% of the credits up to either III year I semester or III year II semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations and secures prescribed minimum attendance in III year II semester.

13. Course Pattern

The entire course of study is for four academic years; all years are on semester pattern.

#### 16. Minimum Instruction Days

The minimum instruction days for each semester shall be 90 working days. There shall be no branch transfers after the completion of the admission process. #### 1 Award of B. Tech. Degree

A student will be declared eligible for the award of B. Tech. Degree if he fulfills the following academic regulations:

- a) A student shall be declared eligible for the award of the B. Tech Degree, if he pursues a course of study in not less than three academic years and not more than six academic years. After six academic years from the year of their admission, he/she shall forfeit their seat in B. Tech course and their admission stands cancelled.
- b) The candidate shall register for 121 credits and secure all the 121 credits.
- 2. The attendance regulations of B. Tech. (Regular) shall be applicable to B.Tech (lateral entry).

#### 3. Promotion Rules

A student shall be promoted from second year to third year if he fulfills the minimum attendance requirement.

A student shall be promoted from III year to IV year if he fulfills the academic requirements of 40% of the credits up to either III year I semester or III year II semester from all the examinations, whether or not the candidate takes the examinations and secures prescribed minimum attendance in III year II semester.

#### 4. Award of Class

After a student has satisfied the requirement prescribed for the completion of the program and is eligible for the award of B. Tech. Degree, he shall be placed in one of the following four classes:

#### COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT

#### Introduction

1. Community Service Project is an experiential learning strategy that integrates meaningful community service with instruction, participation, learning and community development

2. Community Service Project involves students in community development and service activities and

applies the experience to personal and academic development.

3. Community Service Project is meant to link the community with the college for mutual benefit. The community will be benefited with the focused contribution of the college students for the village/ local development. The college finds an opportunity to develop social sensibility and responsibility among students and also emerge as a socially responsible institution.

#### Objective

Community Service Project should be an integral part of the curriculum, as an alternative to the 2 months of Summer Internships / Apprenticeships / On the Job Training, whenever there is an exigencywhen students cannot pursue their summer internships. The specific objectives are;

1. To sensitize the students to the living conditions of the people who are around them,

2. To help students to realize the stark realities of the society.

3. To bring about an attitudinal change in the students and help them to develop societal consciousness, sensibility, responsibility and accountability

4. To make students aware of their inner strength and help them to find new /out of box solutions to the social problems.

5. To make students socially responsible citizens who are sensitive to the needs of the disadvantaged sections.

**6.** To help students to initiate developmental activities in the community in coordination with public and government authorities.

7. To develop a holistic life perspective among the students by making them study culture, traditions, habits, lifestyles, resource utilization, wastages and its management, social problems, public administration system and the roles and responsibilities of different persons across different social systems.

Implementation of Community Service Project

1. Every student should put in a minimum of 180 hours for the Community Service Project during the summer vacation.

2. Each class/section should be assigned with a mentor.

3. Specific Departments could concentrate on their major areas of concern. For example, Dept. of Computer Science can take up activities related to Computer Literacy to different sections of people like - youth, women, house-wives, etc

4. A log book has to be maintained by each of the student, where the activities undertaken/involved to

be recorded.

5. The log book has to be countersigned by the concerned mentor/faculty in charge.

6. Evaluation to be done based on the active participation of the student and grade could be awarded by the mentor/faculty member.

7. The final evaluation to be reflected in the grade memo of the student.

8. The Community Service Project should be different from the regular programmes of NSS/NCC/Green Corps/Red Ribbon Club, etc.

9. Minor project report should be submitted by each student. An internal Viva shall also be conducted by a committee constituted by the principal of the college.

10. Award of marks shall be made as per the guidelines of Internship/apprentice/ on the job training

1. A group of students or even a single student could be assigned for a particular habitation or village or municipal ward, as far as possible, in the near vicinity of their place of stay, so as to enable them to commute from their residence and return back by evening or so.

- 2. The Community Service Project is a twofold one
  - a) First, the student/s could conduct a survey of the habitation, if necessary, in terms of their own domain or subject area. Or it can even be a general survey, incorporating all the different areas. A common survey format could be designed. This should not be viewed as a duplication of work by the Village or Ward volunteers, rather, it could be another primary source of data.
  - b) Secondly, the student/s could take up a social activity, concerning their domain or subject area. The different areas, could be like

Role of Students:

- 1. Students may not have the expertise to conduct all the programmes on their own. The students then can play a facilitator role.
- 2. For conducting special camps like Health related, they will be coordinating with the Governmental agencies.
- 3. As and when required the College faculty themselves act as Resource Persons.
- 4. Students can work in close association with Non-Governmental Organizations like Lions Club, Rotary Club, etc or with any NGO actively working in that habitation.
- 5. And also, with the Governmental Departments. If the programme is rolled out, the District Administration could be roped in for the successful deployment of the programme.
- 6. An in-house training and induction programme could be arranged for the faculty and participating students, to expose them to the methodology of Service Learning.

# Timeline for the Community Service Project Activity

#### **Duration: 8 weeks**

1. Preliminary Survey (One Week)

- a) A preliminary survey including the socio-economic conditions of the allotted habitation to be conducted.
- b) A survey form based on the type of habitation to be prepared before visiting the habitation with the help of social sciences faculty. (However, a template could be designed for different habitations, rural/urban.
- c) The Governmental agencies, like revenue administration, corporation and municipal authorities and village secretariats could be aligned for the survey.

Community Awareness Campaigns (Two Weeks)

Based on the survey and the specific requirements of the habitation, different awareness campaigns and programmes to be conducted, spread over two weeks of time. The list of activities suggested could be taken into consideration.

Community Immersion Programme (Four Weeks)

Along with the Community Awareness Programmes, the student batch can also work with any one of the below listed governmental agencies and work in tandem with them. This community involvement programme will involve the students in exposing themselves to the experiential learning about the community and its dynamics. Programmes could be in consonance with the Govt. Departments.

This report will be a basis for the next batch of students visiting that particular habitation. The same report submitted to the teacher-mentor will be evaluated by the mentor and suitable marks are awarded for onward submission to the Institution.

Throughout the Community Service Project, a daily log-book need to be maintained by the students batch, which should be countersigned by the governmental agency representative and theteachermentor, who is required to periodically visit the students and guide them.




# Rawing
